

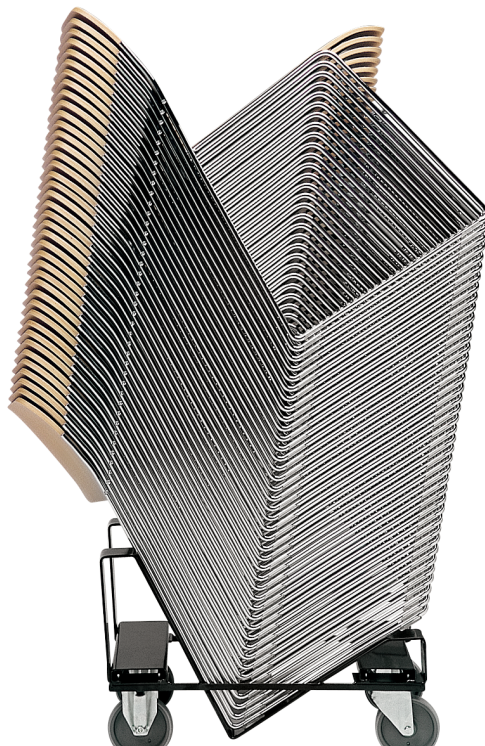

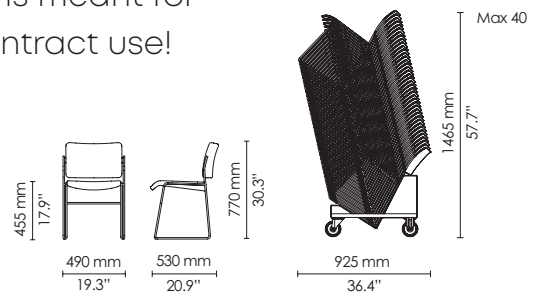

Don't be fooled by the simple and elegant design of the 40/4 chair by David Rowland.

The 40/4 chair has a light and airy aesthetic as well as superb seating comfort - the width of the seat is 490 mm / 19.3". Here we are dealing with a chair that is as strong in construction as it is simple in design.

The frame is made of a solid steel rod and the chair has been tested to both the ANSI/BIFMA X5.1 and the EN 16139:2013 standard for strength and durability.

This chair is meant for severe contract use!

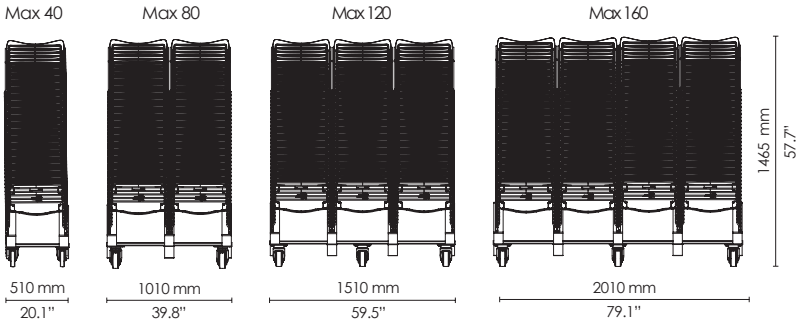

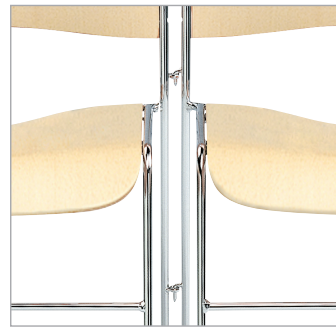
